Comprehensive Curriculum: Our curriculum focuses on all domains of learning including social-emotional, cognitive, physical, spiritual, and communication. Students of all learning levels excel to their fullest potential. When our DMA students move on to high school, they are fully prepared for the continuation of their academic journey. We also make arts integration an integral part of our curriculum. Not only do we have an excellent fine arts program encompassing visual arts, vocal music, instrumental band, and theater, but our teachers also incorporate the arts into their everyday curriculum. In addition, we are in the process of building on our programs by updating our library/media space and adding a STREAM (Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Arts, Math) Lab. Learning doesn't stop at the final school bell, however, as we also have a rich athletic program and a variety of other after school activities.

Commitment and Collaboration: We have an amazing faculty and staff who give their all every day. They are committed fully to the education and well-being of all of our students. They are passionate about what they do, and it is apparent in their interactions with their students, the school families, and each other. They collaborate with each other on a regular basis to bring the best program possible to the students. Each teacher's classroom has a SmartBoard, and we have a 1:1 Chromebook ratio for our students in grades 2-8 as well as class sets of Chromebooks, iPads, and tablets which are used with our PreK-1st graders. The teachers integrate technology into their daily classroom programs to enhance student learning. Our teachers believe in providing the students with the best academic program possible with the desire for them to have all the skills and tools necessary to succeed in our world today
